## Current Responsibilities

Kim Painter is APAH's Vice President of Talent and Collaboration, with a focus on sustaining strong staff and board leadership for the organization.

In this role she oversees human resources, operations, and special collaborative projects - both internal and external - including managing APAH's supportive housing partnerships and APAH's diversity, equity, and inclusion initiatives. Under Kim's leadership, APAH has doubled the size of the staff team since 2018 to advance APAH's mission and meet regional affordable housing needs.

Kim first joined APAH in 2007 as an Asset Manager. From 2007 to 2012, her financial oversight and clear communication with the management company improved the financial position of all of APAH's properties significantly. Her efforts have contributed to APAH's excellent reputation in providing resident relocation services, quality housing and access to housing to those who need additional support.

In 2013, Kim became APAH's Chief of Staff. In this role, she ensured effective integration of people, projects, and systems. She oversaw recruitment and onboarding, office operations, and training in development.

In 2021, she was promoted to Director of Talent and Collaboration and in 2023, she was promoted to Vice President, Talent and Collaboration. Her broad experience enables Kim to ensure the effective integration of people, projects, and systems, key to APAH's successful growth.

Kim co-chaired the Housing Committee of Arlington's Homelessness Continuum of Care and was named to Virginia Housing Coalition's Top 40 Network in 2015.
